Day 2



Located right in the middle of the summer pulse, enjoy direct views of the pool and dip in the sea whenever you wish.

Day 3



Your driver guide will take you to Glyfada, where you can spend the where the locals go to shop and play by the sea. Home turf to millionaires and popstars, this most commercial of beachy suburbs lies 16km from the Acropolis, where it proudly flaunts its "L.A. airs". Welcome to glitzy Glyfada, unofficial capital of the Athens Riviera. There are luxe, leafy pockets where you might indeed be on Rodeo Drive: jazzy Kyprou and Laodikis Streets with their upscale boutiques, imported palm trees and styleconscious, outdoor cafes.

Day 4



This tour perfectly combines the city's highlights: the historic city center, the Acropolis and the New Acropolis Museum. Your private VIP licensed guide will meet you at your hotel and begin with an introduction about the city's history. A luxury vehicle will drive you through Syntagma Square, the Parliament, and the monument of the Unknown Soldier. Then you will make a stop at the Panathenaic Stadium. Continuing to University Street, you will see the Academy of Athens and the National Library. En route to the Acropolis you'll pass the National Gardens and the remains of Temple of Olympian Zeus and Arch of Hadrian. You will then be dropped at the foot of the Acropolis and ascend the Acropolis Hill; a breathtaking view of the city below will unfold. Last, the tour continues with a visit to the New Acropolis Museum a 10-minute walk from the Acropolis Hill. Then your private guide will also take you to Athens' oldest and most picturesque areas: Plaka, Monastiraki, and Psyrri. Here you will discover how modern and ancient Athens coexist in harmony and will be a great opportunity to break for lunch. The tour will end with your choice of visiting the Ancient Agora or the National Archaeological Museum.

Day 5



Enjoy a guided tour of Hydra with a Pardo 38 Motorboat cruise followed by a and walking tour. Built in the shape of an amphitheater on a slope overlooking the Argosaronic gulf, Hydra is one of the most romantic destinations in Greece. Traditional stone mansions, narrow cobblestoned streets, secluded squares and above all the banning of cars and the use of around 500 donkeys as means of public transportation, explain the reason why Hydra preserved its distinctive atmosphere through the passage of time. The island experienced exceptional economic growth in the past thanks to its great naval and

commercial activity. The Hydriots contributed significantly also to the 1821 War of Independence as their powerful fleet participated in crucial sea battles. It is rather impressive the fact that such a tiny island is the birthplace of five Greek Prime Ministers!

Drawing its name from the Sanskrit-derived word for 'peace' and zoe (pronounced zoi), the Greek word for 'life', Amanzoe is situated on a hilltop close to the quaint town of Porto Heli on the east coast of the Peloponnese. Today, your driver guide will take you to Epidaurus, which is about one hour from Amanzoe. While Epidaurus is really an Ancient Greek town with its own theater, stadium and agora, it is the theater (4th century B.C.) that everyone visits and this for its astonishing acoustics. You will also explore the small museum onsite as well as the rest of the city which is still under excavation.

Day 8



Enjoy a cruise aboard a Wally Boat to Spetses, an island with rich naval history and has long been a favorite destination of the Athenian aristocracy. The carefully preserved neoclassical vernacular distinguishes it from other islands and the restriction of traffic to only horse-drawn carriages and bicycles only adds to its dignified, timeless character. Though traditional in many

ways, the island is far from behind the times. During the summer months, the bars in the port of Dapia are buzzing whilst restaurants and tavernas offer traditional cuisine with contemporary influences. During the day there are beaches for all tastes and plenty of activities and excursions for everyone to enjoy.


Day 9

On the northern part of the cosmopolitan town of Oia in Santorini, lies hidden a well-kept secret. Canaves Epitome is located right out of the main town, above the picturesque fishing town of Ammoudi. A serene location awaits those who are ready to experience Santorini from another perspective.

Day 10



Start with embarkation from Ammoudi and sail close to the caldera cliffs cruising below Oia, Imerovigli, Fira and the Volcano. First stop is at the Hot Springs for 30 minutes of swimming and mud bath in the thermal waters. Then we cruise by Aspronisi, Akrotiri and Indian Rock. The second stop will be at the White Beach for about an hour for swimming, snorkeling and for an onboard barbeque. The menu includes local delicacies with salads, fruits, soft drinks as well as Santorinian wine. Last stop is at the Red Beach for swimming and snorkeling.

Day 11



After meeting with your guide at your hotel, you will start from Pyrgos, the largest preserved village on Santorini and the island's former capital. Strategically built in the heart of the pre-volcanic hinterland and at the foot ofMt. Profitis Ilias, Pyrgos affords

panoramic views. As a typical Fortress Settlement of the Cyclades, on the hilltop you will find ruins of Kasteli Castle, one of the five 'kastelia' on the island. Your guide will take your through the traditional architecture, remains of neo-classical mansions, narrow winding paths leading up the hillside, small white houses, galleries, vineyards, churches with their rich ecclesiastical history of the village.

Afterwards, we will head towards the local winery of Venetsanos, with stunning views of the caldera cliffs. At Venetsanos Winery, we'll taste a variety of 4 different wines along with some assorted snacks. You will have some time to explore the village of Megalochori, a traditional village which is virtually untouched by tourism. There you will see the old houses and wineries with the local architecture, which were built with high walls in order to be protected from the pirates. You will pass through the traditional vineyards were the grapes grow inside a basket to be protected from the strong winds. Our volcanic soil gives to our wines a unique taste. You will also visit one of the traditional churches of Megalochori, Saint George, where you can enjoy the magnificent view of Megalochori.

You will then continue to the Ancient Ruins of Akrotiri. Often compared to Pompeii, Akrotiri boasts a much earlier age and preserves amazing ruins dating back to the second millennium BC. Learn about the island's first inhabitants, who arrived there in 3000 BC. Hear from your private VIP licensed guide the story of thefabledcity of Atlantis thathas been one of the oldest living legends of mankind that remains unanswered.
