



Day 1



3 Nights

Duration

Set among the spectacular mountains of Interlaken, the Victoria-Jungfrau offers discerning guests a blend of modern comforts, tradition, and Old-World charm. This afternoon your driver guide will take you to explore Harder Kulm, the closest mountain to the vibrant town of Interlaken. Interlaken is a small town in the mountainous Bernese Oberland region of Switzerland. Harder Kulm Interlaken is 1300 meters above sea level and while it is not as well-known as other mountains in the region, it offers sweeping vistas of Interlaken. It also offers a chance to get up close with Alpine beauty.

Day 2



This excursion takes you to the very heart of the Bernese Alps - the mighty Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau, which form an imposing nucleus of the Alpine Region. Your guide will take you to Interlaken Ost station, where you will take the train into the Waterfall Valley of Lauterbrunnen. You will then change and board the train to Jungfraujoch, the highest railway station in Europe. Next, you will visit the Ice Palace and the Sphinx Terraces - reached by lift with breathtaking views of the Aletsch Glacier, the largest river of ice in Europe. Return to the cogwheel train station Eigergletscher, where you will take the Eiger Express cable car to the mountaineering village of Grindelwald. Enjoy the view on the mighty mountains, before returning to Interlaken.


Day 3



Head to the Interlaken Ost train station, where you will board the train to Bern. Upon your arrival, meet your guide for your private walking tour. Stroll through the UNESCO World Heritage Site and explore all the greatest sights, but also the little alcoves, fountains, towers, and arcades. Traverse the city's Old Town, which extends from the loop of the river Aare, across the "Moränenhügel" westwards to the site of the medieval fortifications. Continue with a visit to the western city gate and tour the

Clock Tower. Here you will enjoy a unique view over the rooftops and streets of Bern. Also, discover ancient technology and benefit from the performance of the clockwork figures and workings of the astronomical clock.



After exploring the city of Bern, you will be taken by private transfer to Hightide Kayak School. Enjoy the beautiful views in the Bernese Oberland from Lake Brienz. Starting from Bönigen, where you travel with your experienced guide across the River Lütschine, heading towards the north shore, exploring beautiful cliffs, the 12th century Ringgenberg castle and hidden beaches along the way. Your guide will offer instruction on how to develop your paddling skills and will also capture your experience with lots of photos to show to your friends and family back home. Your guide will then lead you back to the Bern Train Station, where you will board the train for the one-hour journey back to Interlaken.

Day 4



Welcome to Gruyères, city of the counts of Gruyères in bygone days; today, a village awaiting discovery that invites guests to stroll and partake of fine foods. An architectural jewel filled with treat-it delights the eyes and warms the heart. Here the population is glad to welcome you and to share its traditions, culture, art of cooking, and savoir-faire with its guests. The castle of Gruyères, one of Switzerland's historical monuments that attract the most visitors, boasts medieval treasures, paintings, gardens, and an exhibition of fantasy art along with all its mysteries. The whole region, home of the authentic Gruyère cheese, is also an area devoted to leisure and relaxation.

The car-free resort Zermatt is located at an altitude of 1620m / 5300ft above sea level. This idyllic village in the Matter Valley nestles amongst fabulous scenery of mountains and glaciers and offers visitors a fantastic panorama of 38 four-thousand-meter peaks. The most popular of those peaks is the world's most famous rock Mount Matterhorn, a natural pyramid also featured on the Toblerone chocolate. Zermatt offers a huge choice of culinary delights and a wide range of outdoor activities including skiing in the middle of summer.



3 Nights

Welcome to the Grand Hotel Zermatterhof in the heart of the enchanting mountain world of Zermatt. The resort of Zermatt presents the unique combination of a cosmopolitan lifestyle along with numerous sporting activities in the mountains surrounding the famous Matterhorn. First opened in 1879, Grand Hotel Zermatterhof is a traditional luxury establishment in a central but peaceful location in Zermatt.

Day 5



Today's private excursion is to Mount Gornergrat. Virtually every region has its "must" - and in the Alps, it is the Gornergrat. Experience the breathtaking circular panorama from an altitude of 10,000 feet above sea level. Admire the powerful majesty of rock faces, the silver glitter of eternal snow, and the sheen of icefalls and glaciers - and naturally the very king of the mountains - the Matterhorn with its crown princes the Monte Rosa and Weisshorn.

Day 6



The 5-Seenweg (Five Lakes Hike) is in a class of its own among hikes in the Zermatt mountains. The views of the mountain lakes are superb (with the Matterhorn reflected in three of them), and the trail is full of variety. You will be led by an expert guide, who will take you to paths leading past the lakes of the Stellisee, Grindjisee, Grünsee, Moosjisee and Leisee. Each of these mountain lakes is very different in terms of shape, color, character and size, and has its own special attraction. The Leisee is good for swimming: children love it. The Grünsee looks out over a rather more rugged landscape, where Swiss stone pines nevertheless manage to grow among the scree and sand. The shores of the Grindjisee are home to rare flowers. And so on - each one promises a unique experience.



Take the famous Swiss mountain train "Glacier Express" from Zermatt to Andermatt, from the Matterhorn to the Gotthard massif. A journey lasting 3 hours over numerous bridges, and through many tunnels. A panorama trip through the alpine heartland of Switzerland. The Glacier Express the most memorable way of travelling to and from numerous noteworthy holiday spots. A comfortable train, that takes you through untouched nature, through fragrant and unspoiled mountain forests, tranquil alpine pastures, foaming mountain torrents, through mountain valleys steeped in century-old tradition and culture.

Located in the heart of Switzerland on the picturesque Lake of Lucerne at the foot of the famous Rigi, idyllic Vitznau beckons you to enjoy natural surroundings and a restful vacation. Vitznau is an enchanting oasis tucked away in fascinating countryside. It's a place to discover which has retained its charm and the rustic independence of a rural area and its people. This small locality on the lakeside is the ideal staging post to discover the many sightseeing gems and attractions in the region.

Day 8



Enjoy a private excursion to the historical city of Lucerne. You will find everything here: the lake, the mountains, the city a distinctive consonance of nature and work of man, which has been preserved and carefully developed for centuries. See the Chapel Bridge with its gabled paintings of old battles and the adjacent quaint quarters with little streets and take a leisurely walk through a maze of small streets, bridges, promenades and plazas dominated by countless historical towers, fountains and frescoed buildings.

Enter chocolate paradise for 120 minutes and enjoy a tour of the chocolate-making facilities with a tasting to follow. The experienced chocolatiers are always on hand to tell the stories behind the unique tastes they create. Learn the history of chocolate, taste and create your own chocolate.

Day 9



Your Swiss Getaway ends with your guided excursion to Mount Pilatus. After a drive through Lucerne and Kriens, ascend to Fräkmüntegg by gondolas which sweep you over pine forests and mountain meadows. You will then travel by aerial cable car to Pilatus Kulm. Admire the breathing panorama over the Swiss Alps and Lucerne. Then descend by the steepest cogwheel railway in the world to Alpnachstad. After a leisurely cruise on crystal-clear lake, you will arrive back to Lucerne.
