

As you explore this morning, you will wind in and out of a variety of souks from vegetable markets through the street of butchers, alleys of Harira soup cafes, weavers, carpenters and so much more. Pass the Blue Gate, the shrine of Moulay Idriss, and peak through the many entrances of the massive Al Quaraouiyine Mosque.





You will have a 4x4 and driver included throughout your stay at Dar Ahlam. Visit the Glaoui Kasbah, once a home of a powerful clan. Take a short hike to a spot overlooking the valley and the old salt mines. Another suggested excursion is a visit to the Valley of the Roses. Explore this landscape of foot or by 4x4. Or explore the Skoura Oasis and visit the Kasbah Ameridil, dating to the 14th Century.



The Ksar of Ait Ben Haddou is a fortified village, or ksar, made up of earthen buildings surrounded by high walls and corner towers. It's a traditional pre-Saharan habitat that's considered a great example of Moroccan earthen clay architecture. After your tour, continue on your journey to Marrakesh.



4 Nights

Created by an award-winning British hotelier from three riads in the oldest part of the medina, Riad Farnatchi fuses traditional Moroccan design with a touch of European minimalism. With just ten suites, you will enjoy an intimate atmosphere in a boutique hotel that offers all modern conveniences.

Start your day with a visit to the Jardin Majorelle. The garden was a gift to Marrakesh from Yves-Saint Laurent. Purchased from the painter Jacques Majorelle, the garden is adorned with Majorelle blue, the color named for him. Continue to the Yves-Saint Laurent Museum, opened in October 2017. The museum highlights the life work of the designer, his works and his connection to Marrakech. Visit the opulent Saadien Tombs, the mausoleum of a great dynasty which once ruled North Africa. Continue to

the Slat Al Azama Synagogue in the old mellah. The synagogue has a small museum with rotating exhibitions as well as a focus on the Jewish community of Morocco. Visit the Bahia Palace, a 19th-century palace with a trapezoidal garden, a huge, tiled courtyard, and many hidden treasures.

Day 10



Start your day with a visit to Dar El Bacha, built for Pacha Thami El Glaoui, who ruled over Marrakesh from 1912 to 1956. Opened to the public in 2015, it is one of the medina's finest examples of Moroccan riad architecture and features exhibitions focused on Moroccan culture. Visit the architectural Secret Garden, a recently restored complex showcasing Islamic art and architecture. The garden and adjacent buildings date back 400 years. Visit the Medersa ben Youssef. The Medersa was part seminary, part dormitory and is a splendid example of Moroccan architecture's three core elements: intricate tile mosaics, carved plaster and painted cedar. Explore the endless souks of Marrakesh. Each trade and specialty clusters together over alleyways and squares. The colorful spice souks lead down the metalworkers clanging away.

Day 11



Enjoy a day of leisure or explore at your own pace prior to your transfer back to Casablanca.
